

Taking the Subway from Manhattan to JFK Airport

In Manhattan, access the E Train from:

- Upper East Side (transfer to E Train at 51st St.)
- From Grand Central (take 6 Train to 51st St./transfer to E)
- 5th Ave.
- Midtown
- Port Authority Bus Terminal
- Penn Station
- The West Village
- SoHo
- Chinatown
- World Trade Center

In Manhattan, access the J or Z Line from:

- Lower East Side
- City Hall
- Financial District

1. Walk half a block to AirTrain station and ascend one level
2. Pay AirTrain fare at ticket machine
3. Take AirTrain to your JFK terminal

1. Pay AirTrain fare at ticket machine
2. Take AirTrain to your JFK terminal

ATTENTION A LINE PASSENGERS

The A Line has two branches:

- ✓ One branch goes toward Far Rockaway (board this one)
- ✗ One branch goes toward Ozone Park-Lefferts Blvd. (do not board this one)

Be sure your trains says "Far Rockaway" on the front and/or sides.

Your destination = Howard Beach/JFK Airport station.

If you board a train going toward Ozone Park-Lefferts Blvd. by mistake, transfer at the Rockaway Blvd. station.
